Moorsbus M7 from Pickering (*connecting with M1 from Hull, Beverley & Malton*)

Moorsbus M4 from Stockton, Middlesbrough, Guisborough & Stokesley  
*Saturdays and Sundays April to end September*

### **Sproxtton**

Transdev / East Yorkshire 31X from York, Easingwold, Kirkbymoorside & Helmsley  
*Monday to Saturday*

Moorsbus M31 from York, Easingwold & Helmsley  
*Sundays April to end September*

Moorsbus M5 from Stokesley, Northallerton, Thirsk & Helmsley  
*Saturdays and Sundays April to end September*

*The most secure parking is at Helmsley (Cleveland Way Car Park) and Sutton Bank Visitor Centre, where there are also catering facilities and toilets,*

*Most first and last bus times will allow for the longest of walks, although see the note for the second leg of Option 1 and the short time available to meet the bus timetable.*

*Note: the Moorsbus Network is organised and developed by a not-for-profit organisation, using contracted bus companies to provide the buses and drivers. Fares are reasonable and follow the maximum fare policy of £3 for a single journey. English National Concessionary Passes are accepted.*
